24 HOUR ROAD BAN IN EFFECT

Based on the present road conditions, all Paramount roads are under a 24-hour road ban effective immediately.

If Essential Travel is necessary, each heavy load will be required to present a permit to Paramount Security or the Bigstone gate.

Paramount will be monitoring these roads closely with road patrols throughout this time. It is the Road Use Agreement Grantee's responsibility to provide all staff covered under the Road Use Agreement with Paramount Resources Ltd. of the road ban notification and essential load access procedures.

Damages resulting from continued use in wet or unfrozen conditions will be the responsibility of the road user and may result in lost road use privileges and additional charges to repair the damages. All other road rules and regulations still apply.
